p.17 A Change In Message (MTKS)

Before he encountered Christ, Paul's message was based on his own understanding (Galatians 1:11–14).

After he encountered Christ, Paul based his message on who Jesus was (Colossians 1:15–18).

After he encountered Christ, Paul's message was based on what Jesus did (Colossians 1:19–23).

p.19 True Messengers

John the Baptist

1. *Lamb of God; greater than John; the Son of God.*
2. *Take away the sin of the world; baptize with the Holy Spirit.*



Peter

1. Accredited by God; performer of miracles; raised from the dead; Son of God; Messiah.
2. Believed, repented, and was baptized; received forgiveness of sins and the Holy Spirit.

Philip

1. Jesus was the subject of Old Testament prophecy; Jesus' life and death were foretold; Philip must have also preached the gospel to the Ethiopian.
2. The Ethiopian believed and was baptized.

John the Apostle

1. The righteous One; God's one and only Son.
2. Atoned for the debt of our sins; gives us life through Himself.

p.27 A Change In Character (MTKS)

Before he met Christ, Paul's actions revealed his flawed character (Acts 22:1–8).

After he met Christ, Paul's actions revealed his heart for Christ (Colossians 3:1–4).

We are to put to death our earthly nature (Colossians 3:5–11).

We are to clothe ourselves with Christ's virtues (Colossians 3:12–14).



p.36 Hidden In Christ (IKS)

Phil. 1:12-13 *He didn't complain about his imprisonment. He saw his confinement as a way to further the gospel.*

Phil. 1:14-18 *Some of his Christian brothers used Paul's imprisonment to bring glory to themselves and heap misfortune on him. He could have been disillusioned or hurt, but he knew the only thing that matters is that Christ is preached.*

Phil. 1:19-21 *Paul wrote that his life was simply Christ! Everything he did was aimed at spreading the name of Christ to the nations.*

p.37 Living Christ (MTKS)

Paul paid the ultimate price for his faith (Acts 28:11–16, 30–31).

Paul valued Christ over his own interests (Phil. 1:12–18).

Paul's identity was found in Jesus Christ (Phil. 1:19–21).
