 - c. She was playing the JoBros new single on repeat.

2. Why did your school principle run cross the road?
 - a. To give you detention.
 - b. **It was taco day and he/she had to get to the lunchroom.**
 - c. He/she had just attended your school band's Spring concert.

3. What is the opposite of purple?
 - a. Yellow
 - b. Ryan Seacrest
 - c. **A Ham Sandwich**

4. If two trains are heading towards each other on the same track, one traveling north at 35 mph, one traveling south at 65 miles an hour, what additional information do you need to determine when they will meet?
 - a. **Which train Taylor Swift is on**
 - b. What time it is in Morocco
 - c. The opposite of purple

5. Complete the following analogy: *Twilight* is to *Moby Dick* as:
 - a. Demi Lovato is to an eggplant.
 - b. **Twenty-one is to 3.14.**
 - c. A waffle iron is to your Spanish teacher.
