## THE CHEERS OF THE PEOPLE

*Biblical Passages:* Luke 19:28–40

*Memory Verse:* Isaiah 29:13

And the Lord said: “Because this people draw near with their mouth and honor me with their lips, while their hearts are far from me, and their fear of me is a commandment taught by men.”

- What did the disciples do that showed obedience to Jesus?
- How did they bring honor to Jesus?

**How did the crowds of people respond to Jesus?** (Mt. 21:8-11)

- What did the crowd do to celebrate Jesus’ coming?
- Who did the crowds of people think Jesus was?

**How did the Pharisees respond to Jesus?** (Lk. 19:36-40)

- Why do you think the Pharisees hated Jesus?
- Why do you think they tried to get Jesus to calm the crowd rather than doing it themselves?
- What do you think Jesus meant by His reply to the Pharisees?
